

Materials accepted at each Household Hazardous Waste collection event

AEROSOLS



Aerosol spray cans contain product and propellant under pressure that can be dispensed as a spray, mist, or foam. Common aerosol can products include insecticides, cooking sprays, solvents, and paints.

AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS

Some car fluids such as Motor Oil, Break Fluid, Antifreeze, Transmission Fluid, Power Steering Fluid, or Windshield Wiper Fluid can be processed and recycled into new fluids.

These type of liquids are considered hazardous and therefore they must be stored and disposed of properly.



DIESEL, KEROSENE & GASOLINE



A limit of 10 gallons per car with tightly closed containers.

The containers will NOT be returned.

CLEANING SUPPLIES & OTHER HOUSHOLD CHEMICALS

Household hazardous chemicals like Oven cleaners, Chlorine Bleach, Ammonia, Rug and Upholstery Cleaners, Furniture and Floor Polish are accepted at each HHW event.



****Never mix bleach or any bleach-containing product with any cleaner containing ammonia. The gases created from this combination can lead to chronic breathing problems and even death****

FLUORESCENT BULBS



All fluorescent tubes up to 8 foot and CFL bulbs will be accepted at each event.

MERCURY CONTAINING DEVICES

Some products such as Thermometers, Barometers, Flow meters, contain Mercury and must be disposed of correctly. We accept all types of items that contain mercury at each event.
