## PROPOSED REGULATION 193 Third Reading and Adoption– November 20, 2025

A REGULATION ESTABLISHING AND REVISING LICENSE, PERMIT AND SERVICE FEES IN THE WAYNE COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT TOWARD COSTS OF PROVIDING ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AND INSPECTIONS:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Wayne County Combined General Health District, state of Ohio, that fees are established under authority of Ohio Revised Code Sections 3709.09 and 3717.07. Additional authority applies under Ohio Revised Code Sections 3717.25 for Retail Food Establishment license fees; 3717.45 for Food Service Operation license fees; 3717.01 for Vending; 3717.09 for Certification in Food Protection; 3701.344 for Private Water Systems; 3718.06 for Sewage Treatment Systems; 3729.10 for Recreation, RV, Combined and Temporary Park-camps; and 3749.04 for Public Swimming Pools; 3730.03 for Tattoo or Body Piercing services.

Each fee outlined below represents only the local component of each license category. Additional fees may be imposed by the State of Ohio. License fees submitted to the Wayne County Combined General Health District shall include the local fees outlined in this regulation and any applicable state fees.

Section 1:      Retail Food Establishment and Food Service Operation License Fees:

(A)    The local per location license fee for vending machines shall be:

\$ 24.99

(B)    The license fee for retail food establishment and food service operations is the same for commercial and non-commercial operations. The local license fee for operations less than 25,000 square feet in size shall be:

Risk Class Operation Level I	\$260.00
Risk Class Operation Level II	\$290.00
Risk Class Operation Level III	\$520.00
Risk Class Operation Level IV	\$645.00

(C)    The license fee for retail food establishment and food service operations is the same for commercial and non-commercial operations. The local license fee for operations more than 25,000 square feet in size shall be:

Risk Class Operation Level I	\$350.00
Risk Class Operation Level II	\$370.00
Risk Class Operation Level III	\$1230.00
Risk Class Operation Level IV	\$1300.00

(D) The per unit license fee for mobile food service operations and retail food establishments shall be:

Mobile High Risk	\$230.00
Mobile Low Risk	½ Cost High Risk

(E) The per day license fee for temporary retail food establishments and food service operations, shall be:

\$65.00

(F) The fee for the review of facility layout and equipment specifications for food service operations and retail food establishments other than mobile or temporary or vending machine locations, billed in 15 minute increments shall be (only for new applications received on/after Regulation effective date):

\$60.00/Hr

(G) The fee for collection and bacteriological examination of any necessary or requested water samples paid with license, as defined in sections 3717.25 and 3717.45 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be:

\$50.00

**Section 2:** Recreational Parks/Campgrounds

(A) First 50 Sites shall be: \$350.00

(B) Each Additional Site Over 50 shall be: \$4.51

(C) Temporary Camp – Per EVENT fifty or fewer sites shall be: \$120.00

(D) Temporary Camp- Each Additional Site Over 50 shall be: \$1.25

**Section 3:** Individual Public Swimming Pools, Individual Public Spas, Individual Special Use Pools, Additional Units

(A) Individual Public Swimming Pool shall be: \$360.00

(A) Individual Spa shall be: \$292.00

(B) Individual Special Use Pool shall be: \$242.00

**Section 4:** Tattoo and Body Piercing Services

(A) License (Tattooing and Body Piercing) shall be: \$ 275.00

(B) New Facility Plan Review shall be: \$ 3/4 of Current License Fee

(C) Time-limited approval for a specific event shall be: \$60.00

**Section 5:** Private Water Systems

(A) The fee for the Construction of Single Fam/Non Single (No pond) \$381.00\*

\*includes 2 bacteriological samples

(C) The fee for the alteration of a Single Fam/ Non Single \$250.00

(D) The fee for Conversion, Holding, Cistern Single Fam/ Non-Single \$361.00

(E) The fee for a re-inspection \$75.00

**Section 6:** Sewage Treatment Systems

(A) The fee for permit to Install/Replace (HSTS, SFOSTS, GWRS) \$401.00\*  
\*includes 1 re-inspection

(B) The fee for a permit to alter (HSTS, SFOSTS, GWRS) \$240.00\*  
\*includes 1 re-inspection

(C) The fee for a Pre-Site Review Evaluation \$75.00

(D) The fee for a Septic Repair Inspection Fee \$75.00

(E) The fee for a Septic Re-inspection \$75.00

**Section 7:** Non-Mandated Inspections- An optional service available when requested for real estate transfers.

(A) Request for real estate sewage inspection fee shall be: \$250.00\*  
\* Includes Dye Test and hydraulic load and 1 re-inspection

(B) Request for real estate well inspection fee shall be: \$200.00\*\*  
\*\*Includes flowrate and bacteria and nitrate pre-test

**Section 8:** Repeal

Existing sections or paragraphs of other regulations of the Board of Health of the Wayne County Combined General Health District which are in conflict or inconsistent with this regulation are hereby repealed.

**Section 9:** Penalty

Any person who violates any provision of this regulation shall be in violation of 3709.09 and/or 3709.21 and/or 3709.22 and/or 3707.01 and/or 3707.48 of the Ohio Revised Code Sections and shall be subject to the penalties of 3709.99 and/or 3707.99 of the Ohio Revised Code Sections.


**Section 10:** Effect of Partial Invalidity


